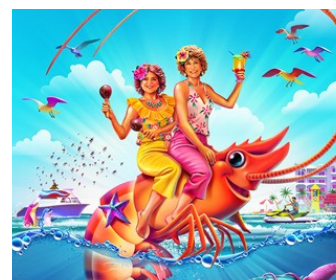
#### **Barb and Star Go to Vista Del Mar**

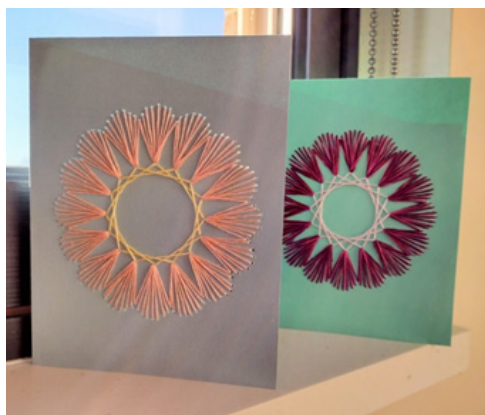
