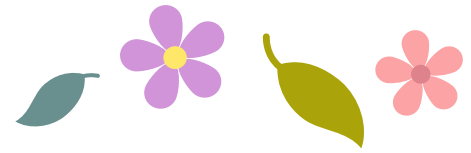

No Sew Tee Shirt Tote Bag

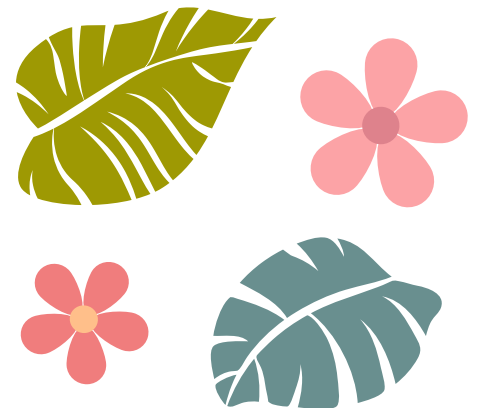
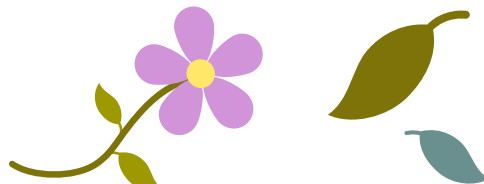
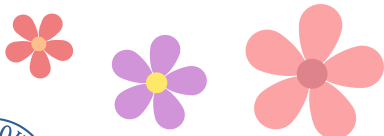
Tuesday, March 21 at 6:30 PM
