Come to the library for a fun game of Bingo. [Registration required for all ages.]

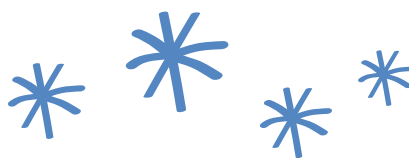
